Youth and Family

End of Youth Programs:

We are wrapping up all our youth programs for the year! May 11th is the last day of Sunday school and May 14th is the last day of Connect. Confirmation ends May 4th, but students are welcome to work on materials all summer long - just check in with Pastor Kayla. We will wrap up the year with one final Youth Led Sunday on May 18th - get signed up!

Vacation Bible School: Our Savior's Lutheran Church and Zion Lutheran Church are looking forward to our summer Vacation Bible School program. We are hosting Camp Metigoshe for a Day Camp that will be held at our congregation July 21- 25 for students entering PreK - 6th grades.

Metigoshe's trained staff will be here to lead an amazing experience for our youth with the help of volunteers from our congregation. This summer's theme is "G.L.U.E...GOD LOVES US EVERYWHERE!" We will read through the Book of Jonah and dig into the four day themes:

- God loves us when we make mistakes.
- God loves us when we are down.
- God loves us when we listen.
- God loves us when we are angry.

Days will consist of lots of games, singing, arts & crafts, snacks, SWAT (Bible study), and much more. Day Camp will begin at 9:00 am and will end at 3:00 PM Monday through Thursday. Friday will be a short day, running from 9:00 to 11:30. If your child is entering PreK or Kindergarten, their day will run from 9:00 to noon M-Th and 9:00 to 11:30 on Friday. We will have a closing program for campers to share with parents and congregation members what they learned during the week.

We also had a large building project early on with replacing the windows in our office addition, which will hopefully save on heating and cooling costs long term.
